

## Exercise setting:

Based on a UN Security Council Resolution, military forces separated 2 conflicting parties, within a fictitious Europe, into A-Land and B-Land.

Subsequently, UN Forces were maintaining a safe and secure environment within a demilitarized zone set up between both countries.

After renewed attacks of terrorist organizations, which UN Troops were not able to prevent, A-Land started again attacks against B-Land and occupied parts of its territory.

On demand of the UN, the EU committed military forces to the conflict area. Under the lead of the Austrian 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry Brigade, a Multinational Task Force is on its way to this area in order to reestablish a safe and secure environment and to separate the conflicting parties, if necessary by force.
